

MEN'S RULES

Collegiate Classic Baseball Tournament Rules

All games will be 9 inning games unless the two teams are playing a doubleheader that day. Then the decision will be in the hands of the coaches with the DH.

Umpires shall get the final scores of each game worked and report it to field manager.

There will be no 10 run rule; all games must go at least 7 innings with the exception being games stopped due to inclement weather.

Stoppage of game due to rain is at the umpire's discretion.

There is no time limit on games.

New This year: When grounds crews complete the field prep prior to a game, teams will evenly split the remaining time prior to the game. **ALL GAME TIMES ARE START TIMES.**

When taking Batting Practice please use the fungo nets. It is the responsibility of each team to place the nets before they take practice and remove them when finished.

Using the batting cages **NO METAL CLEATS** are allowed.

Coaches are to ensure that all players stay in the dugouts or are outside the fenced area. This will be closely monitored by staff and umpires.

Threats toward umpires, other coaches and players, and staff will result in the enforcement of NCAA Rules regarding unsportsmanlike conduct. The appropriate forms will be filed and your college/university will be notified.

The home team will be designated by a coin toss by the coaches before the game. Exception: If teams are playing a doubleheader with each other the first game home second visitor.

All teams are required to have at least 6 balls for each game.

Clean out your dug out after each game.
